Josh Beckett carries Boston Red Sox World Series hopes to the mound on Thursday for a must-win Game Five against the Cleveland Indians and they could not be in safer hands. Trailing the Cleveland Indians 3-1 in their best-of-seven American League Championship Series and teetering on the brink of elimination, the Red Sox's Cy Young candidate is all that

stands between the Indians and a return to the World Series.

Just in case you missed it or have been sleeping through the baseball playoffs the Colorado Rockies are going to the World Series. With their 21st win in 22 games, the relentless Rockies beat the rattled Arizona Diamondbacks 6-4 in Game 4 Monday night to sweep the NL Championship Series at chilly Coors Field.
